



Scholarship Application

The Snake River Reining Alliance (SRRA) is offering a \$600.00 scholarship for the academic 2010-2011 school year. The following must apply in order to be considered.

1. A member of the SRRA, and
2. Is enrolled in a college, university, or vocational school for the 2009-2010 school year, as a full time undergraduate student, taking a minimum of 12 hours (or full time equivalent), or
3. Is a high school senior or undergraduate student who will be attending a college, university, or vocational school for the 2010-2011 school year, as a full time undergraduate student, taking a minimum of 12 hours (or full time equivalent), and
4. Is less than 25 years old

The selection of the recipient will be based upon

- ✓ Scholastic achievement,
- ✓ School and community leadership, and
- ✓ Involvement with the SRRA.

The Complete application must be received by **June 30, 2010**, and must include the following:

1. SRRA scholarship application (see www.snakeriverreining.com for a downloadable scholarship application)
2. One letter of recommendation each from
 - a. your high school,
 - b. a member of the community, and
 - c. a member of SRRA
3. A copy of high school transcripts and any college transcripts if applicable
4. Official copy of SAT or ACT results.

All applications received which do not include the above information will be considered incomplete and will not be accepted for consideration. This deadline is firmly June 30th. The Scholarship committee will consist of: SRRA President, SRRA Scholarship Chairman and one SRRA Member. Awards will be made by August 1st, 2010. The scholarship funds will be paid directly to the institution of your choice. Send all applications to.
